Sarnico 60: you can... choose

From where do you like to admire the sea? From a magnificent terrace or from a luxuriously furnished veranda?

The Sarnico 60, a boat of infinity class designed by Nuvolari-Lenard, offers both the options in two versions that share the same modern style and same sporting performance, but which are distinguished by two different layout.

The version "Gran Turismo" is dedicated to those who want to live the boat in all seasons, air-conditioning the upper deck, enclosed by a glass stern window. The stackable and sliding doors allow to open the hall on the sea as well as on the "open" version. In the elegant living room there are a dining table, furniture made of bleached oak and floor of leather. Under the deck in the original version there is also a relaxing area, instead on the GT model there is only a large and well equipped kitchen with a lot of space for the galley that helps you to make long cruises. The refrigerator has a capacity of 244 liters and freezer 101 liters; there are also a wine cellar, four hobs, a large oven and double sink.

The "open" model permit to spend all the day outdoors, thanks to a large sofa, a dining table and a fully equipped kitchen on the main deck.

The two versions have the same sleeping zone: one owner's suite in the middle, a guest cabins at the bow, a totally separate aft cabin for guests and a crew cabin.

On both models, the sliding roof allows you to fully enjoy the thrill of the speed from the pilot house. Pushed by two 1100 hp diesel common rail Man, Sarnico 60 reaches 38 knots and cruises at high speeds even in rough sea, thanks to its hull and to the central position of the engines that further enhances the static and the dynamic stability.
