Sarnico Grande: “feverish” work

Cantieri di Sarnico is producing the new 24 meters flagship which is celebrating its importance also through his name. The Sarnico Grande is the evolution of ideas and experiences gained by the yard in seventeen years. In Capriolo production site the hull designed by Victory Design led by Brunello Acampora reveals all its grandeur and the profile reveals in part the final appearance of the building, designed by Carlo Nuvolari and Dan Lenard.

The mockup of the interior, initially developed in part as usual, was then mounted on board to optimize the space for the best ergonomics through a method that is far more effective than any pc simulation program. This process of building expands the time of execution, but allows to produce a boat of the highest quality and absolute comfort. The interior compartment has been developed with the goal to have large environments and total privacy. The furniture is the result of meticulous and skillful work of artisans. Again we prefer the perfection of our work instead of the speed of assembly. Each component is mounted, finished, disassembled, treated, painted and then remounted. In this way furniture do not need any after finishing work. The materials and all the components of the construction have been chosen according to their weight, because one of the goals of the project is the high cruising speed using low engine power to contain the consumption and the emission, obviously with the advanced technologies of "Man" engines.
